Q: *Can I nominate myself?*

A: **Yes!** Self-nominations will be accepted and encouraged!

Q: *Do I have to work for the business that I nominate?*

A: **No.** Nominations will be accepted in the form of self-nominations from the business owner or chief officer, employees of the business and/or community members. Please try to submit as much known business information as possible to increase odds of being selected.

Q: **Can I enter more than one Award Category?**

A: **Yes.** As long as the criteria for judging are met within each category (ie. size, creation of innovative product or service, or nonprofit status) businesses may apply to more than one category.

Q: **When is the deadline to enter?**

A: All completed nominations must be submitted to rachel@thinkdutchess.com by **July 26, 2019 by 11:59pm**. No entries will be considered after this deadline.
